Cub Camp Kit List

ALL ITEMS MUST BE MARKED WITH OWNERS NAME SO THAT WE CAN TRACE **LOST and FOUND** PROPERTY.

Rucksack or holdall (everything must fit)	2 sweatshirts or fleeces
Cub uniform (to be worn)	2 T-shirts
Hiking Boots (to be worn)	1 pair of shorts (2 if weather is warm & sunny)
Trainers	2 pairs of trousers (not jeans)
Waterproof cagoule & trousers (lightweight)	Pyjamas or Onesie
Warm Coat	Sun hat or baseball cap
Sleeping bag (3-season)	Woolly hat (for evening)
Roll mat for sleeping on	Spare underwear
Empty pillow case or similar (to stuff with clothes for use as a pillow)	Spare socks (minimum 3 pairs)
Fleece blanket	Torch (with fresh batteries)
Sun cream	Spare batteries for torch
Hand towel	Drinking bottle
Toilet bag with flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, tissues	Large plastic bag (empty – to put wet / dirty clothes in
Tea towel	

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Waterproof cagoule & trousers MUST be marked "waterproof" by manufacturer otherwise they are useless. A soggy Cub means problems for everyone!
- 2. Hiking boots means leather or tough fabric, but boots must be supportive and preferably waterproof. (Note for older Cubs if considering purchasing new boots; fabric boots are not suitable for Scout camps.)
- 3. Please do not bring electrical equipment such as phones etc. to camp. We are not insured for loss or damage and they can cause distractions.
- 4. Please do not send large amounts of snacks / sweets with your child. This causes problems at meal times when Cubs have no appetite and can also attract insects and rodents into the tents.
- 5. If your child helps you to pack he/she will know what was brought and is less likely to misplace items
- 6. Your child will be out-of-doors for the weekend; please consider the weather forecast when packing and make sure your child has enough warm / waterproof clothes, a roll mat and warm sleeping bag.
